The Institute has been bringing out a Research Journal – Anveshana with ISSN, continuously for last 8 years. The journal is indexed in J-gate and Proquest, the online journal portals and also applied for UGC for listing.

Library and Computer lab-

The institute has an excellent digital library comprising latest books and journals on Management. At present, we are subscribing to 45 periodicals and the total number of books is 15,051. In addition, the Institute is subscribing to two on line journal portals: J-gate and Proquest. A separate and spacious air conditioned computer lab with a provision of 80 workstations is maintained with Wired LAN, Security network, Server requirements, Wi-fi connectivity and 32 MBPS leased line internet access.
